**Due to limited staff, a Child Watch shift will not be offered when staff are sick or unable to work their shift. Parents are encouraged to call the YMCA prior to coming.**

**FREE Child Watch Service Offered**  
**\*For Family Members Age 2 years to 8 years old\***  
**\*Maximum of 10 children in the room at any given time\***

Child Watch is for Henderson YMCA Members ONLY due to limited space. Children, as well as the parents, grandparents, brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, or legal guardians who bring a child into the Child Watch Center must ALL be Henderson YMCA members. The above immediate family members, age 18 and older, may bring a child into the Child Watch Center. Babysitters who are also members of our YMCA may bring other YMCA members' children, ONLY after the parents fill out and sign a Permission and Liability Waiver Form that is available at the Service Desk.

**The Henderson YMCA Child Watch Staff will provide the following services, and abide by the following policies:**

1. Child Watch staff will watch over all the children in the room to provide a safe place until the child's parent picks them up. There is only 1 staff per shift, and it is possible that Child Watch could become full during any shift.
2. No food or drink can be taken into the Child Watch Center, and none will be provided by staff.
3. Staff will provide appropriate TV programs or videos for the children to watch.
4. The children are allowed to bring 1 toy, book, etc. to play with, however, the YMCA will not be responsible if any of these items get lost or damaged during Child Watch.
5. Due to limited staffing, as well as Safety and Liability concerns, our Child Watch staff is not allowed to bottle-feed, hand-feed, hold, or rock the children.
6. We request that parents of any child still wearing diapers to please change them prior to bringing their child to the Child Watch Center, and that parents of older children take their child to the bathroom before bringing them. There is a changing table in each locker room.
7. If inclement weather occurs, please call before coming to the YMCA to see if Child Watch will be offered.

**Board Approved Formal Policies (September 17, 2001)**

- For safety reasons, a parent or any immediate family member who brings children into the Child Watch Center MUST remain inside the YMCA at all times. Failure to do so will result in termination of further use of the YMCA's free Child Watch service.
- For sanitation reasons, changing diapers inside the Child Watch Center is not allowed. The parent or immediate family member will be paged to come and take the child to the locker room to change the child's diaper. Child Watch staff are not allowed to leave the Child Watch Center during their shift, and are not allowed to change a child's diaper.

*The YMCA reserves the right to modify or discontinue this Service at any given time, especially if fewer than 5 different families are using the times offered.*
